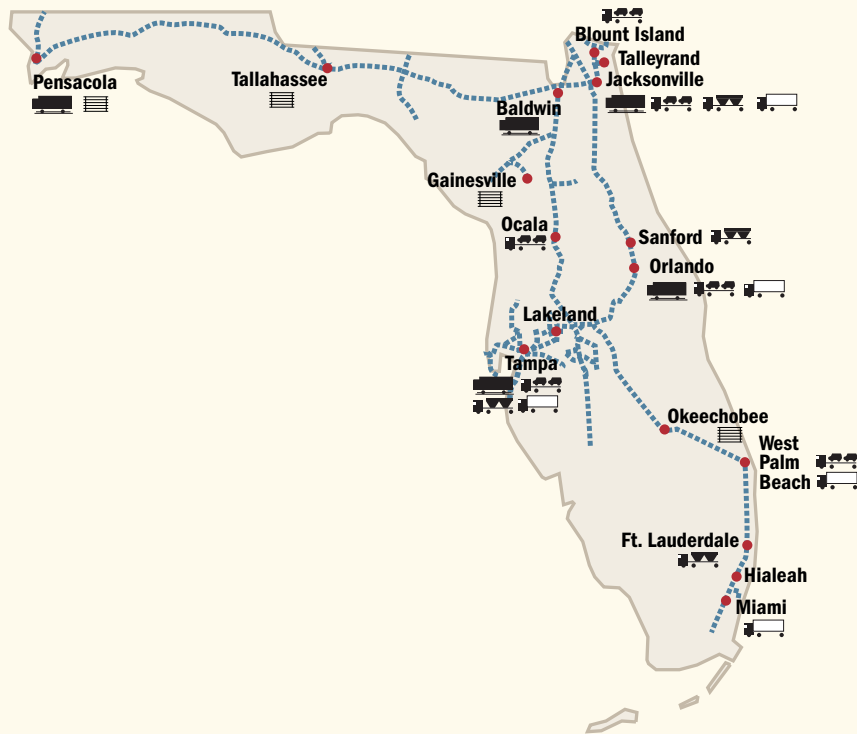



The Role of the Railroad in Florida

CSXT Impact and Operations

- Operates over and maintains 1,750 miles of track
- Operates through 2,400 grade crossings
- Handles more than 508,000 carloads of freight annually at local yards
- Employs more than 6,000 Florida residents with an annual payroll of approximately \$400 million in 2004
- Provides service to 780 industries and created 350 jobs in Florida
- Invested \$22 million to maintain and upgrade its track in Florida in 2004
- Products shipped include coal, orange juice, sugar, fertilizer, feed, phosphate, limestone, new and used automobiles and aggregates

Jacksonville

- CSX Corporation headquarters
- CSXT's Centralized Operations Center which directs train operations for much of CSXT's 21,000 route-mile network
- More than 4,000 CSX employees work in Jacksonville

CSXT Facilities

- Major rail yards in Jacksonville (Moncrief Yard), Tampa and Baldwin
- Locomotive servicing facilities in Hialeah, Jacksonville (Moncrief Yard), Lakeland, Orlando, Pensacola, Tallahassee and Tampa

- Car repair shops in Baldwin, Hialeah, Jacksonville, Lakeland, Orlando, Pensacola, Tallahassee and Tampa
- CSX Intermodal terminals in Jacksonville, Miami, Orlando, West Palm Beach and Tampa
- Rail-to-truck metals distribution facilities in Ft. Lauderdale and Tampa
- Rail-to-truck TRANSFLOSM transloading facilities in Ft. Lauderdale, Jacksonville, Sanford and Tampa
- Finished Automobile Distribution Centers (TDSI) in Blount Island, Jacksonville (Moncrief Yard), Ocala, Orlando, West Palm Beach and Tampa

Environmental Advantages of Rail

- Every railcar trip removes approximately three truck trips from congested highways.
- Railroads can move one ton of freight three times as far as a truck on a gallon of fuel.
- On a per ton-mile basis, railroads emit one-tenth the hydrocarbons and diesel particulates of trucks, and one-third the oxides of nitrogen and carbon.

Commuter Rail Operations

- South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) operates three trains daily between Miami and West Palm Beach.
- The state of Florida owns tracks; CSXT has freight rights over it.
- Amtrak operates approximately 60 trains per day over 34 percent of CSXT railroad in every state except Tennessee, New Jersey and Delaware.
